Current negative Coggins Test Certificates required for all horses on grounds.

Riders who enter Walk/Trot classes are prohibited from entering other classes
with the exceptions of speed events and the Open Jackpot Walk/Trot, which is
open to all riders.

Show will not refund/exchange for classes incorrectly chosen. Please be sure to
circle the correct class.
