Please check-in upon arrival for stall assignment & shavings.

Classes may be added up to 3 classes prior.

Scratches will not be refunded without a vet excuse.

Schooling will be allowed after check-in with signed waiver and paid stall during the following: Fri. 4 - 9 p.m. & Sat. 6 - 8:30 a.m.

Please mail pre-entries no later than six days prior. Entries will be accepted at the NEC office (please call for times) through January 21 or at the show office on January 22.

Current negative Coggins Test Certificates required for all horses on grounds.

Riders who enter Walk/Trot classes are prohibited from entering other classes with the exceptions of speed events and the Open Jackpot Walk/Trot, which is open to all riders.

Show will not refund/exchange for classes incorrectly chosen. Please be sure to circle the correct class.

## JUDGES DECISION FINAL

To be eligible for series high point class awards you must pay a nomination fee per class, per horse before showing in that class.
