#### **SMBHA SHOW RULES**

- To show in IBHA approved classes, submit a copy of the IBHA papers and cards with your show entries. Out of state horses will have to show valid current health papers and all horses show negative Coggins papers.
- 2. All shows will start on time unless adverse conditions prevail.
- 3. First five classes will close ten minutes prior to show time.
- 4. Classes may be entered up to two classes in advance of the class being entered.
- 5. No classes will be canceled unless there are no entries in the class.
- 6. All horses that are not entered in a particular class that in the show ring will be excused.
- Please notify the ring steward of any tack change(s).
- 8. Dun factor classes will be held outside if possible. Judges shall decide if weather is prohibitive.
- Western attire is required in all western classes, including western hat. Speed horse exhibitors may wear a cowboy hat or helmet, providing the hat/helmet remain on the exhibitor's person during the entire event or a 5 second penalty will be assessed. English classes require English attire, including helmet. Jackets may be optional at the judges' discretion due to
- 10. Language: Foul or abusive language will not be permitted. Drinking: Drunk or disorderly conduct will not be permitted. Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in being barred from the show grounds.
- 11. Any performance class may be required to drop their bits at the discretion of rules person, show management and/or judge(s).
- 12. In order to run a tab at our horse shows a signed check must be left in the horse show office with the first entry. Cash entries pay as they enter each class.
- 13. All SMBHA show rules will coincide with the IBHA show rules. See IBHA Handbook and SMBHA Show Rules for further information.
