High point & Reserve High Point All-Around awards given in: Walk-Trot, 13 & Under, and 14 & Over. Ribbons will be given to the **Top 5** Places in each class.

- ▶ **Nominations:** To qualify for High Point Award, horse **must be shown in showmanship**. The Award is based on a one rider and one horse team. All Classes count towards your High Point Category. Points earned in "All ages" or "Ponies" classes contribute towards your High Point Category **except #1, 2, 16 and 32**. The Point System will be posted at the show.
- ▶ **Walk-Trot** riders may not enter classes that lope. Walk Trot is "recommended" for exhibitors in 1st or 2nd year of horse project and have not won a ribbon at the Missouri State Fair horse show.
- ▶ **NO Stallions;**

* **Properly fitted ASTM and SEI certified helmets will be required for all events in classes 16 and 33-41. A rider will be disqualified if the helmet is not on the exhibitor's head and fastened for the entire time the exhibitor is in the arena.**
