**From I-64E/US-40E:** To the Weidman Road Entrance: Take exit 22 for MO-141; Keep right at the fork, follow signs for MO-141S/Woods Mill Rd; Exit onto Clayton Rd; Turn left at the light onto Clayton Rd; Turn right at Weidman Rd. Park will be on your left at a light about 1.7 miles.

**From I-270:** To the Weidman Road Entrance: I-270 to Manchester Road; west on Manchester Road for 2.5 miles; make a right turn at light onto Weidman Road for .5 mile; Queeny Park entrance is on the right - follow signs to trailer parking.

## Rules and Regulations

1. Except where otherwise noted, USEF/USDF and MHSA rules will apply
2. CRUELTY to or the abuse of a horse by any person at a member show is forbidden, constitutes a violation, and renders the offender subject to penalty. The competition committee shall bar violators from further participation for the remainder of the show.
3. No Braiding Necessary
4. Informal attire allowed. All riders must wear hard hats or competition-appropriate headgear. Paddock boots and half chaps are allowed.
5. The 2011 USEF Dressage tests will be used for all classes except Intro classes, which will use 2011 USDF Introductory test. USEF tests are available for download in PDF format from the web at <http://www.usdf.org/downloads/forms/index.asp?TypePass=Tests>
6. The 2010 USEF Tests for Eventing Dressage will be used for the eventing dressage classes. These tests can be found at <http://useventing.com/competitions.php?section=dressage>
7. MAIDEN HORSE classes are open to **horses** which have never won a blue ribbon at the specified level at a USEF or USDF recognized show.
8. MAIDEN RIDER classes are open to **riders** who have never won a blue ribbon at a specified level at a USEF or USDF recognized show.
9. In classes 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21, more than one test may be ridden but each test will carry a separate fee. State test(s) to be ridden on entry form. Classes will be split if entries permit.
10. All tests to be ridden in a plain snaffle except Third Level or above, where full bridle is optional.
11. Awards through sixth place for all classes.
12. A negative Coggins test, dated within one year, must be submitted with entry and must accompany each horse arriving on the grounds.
13. RIDE TIMES: An email will be sent to you when ride times are posed on [www.qpee.org](http://www.qpee.org). On May 5th you may call Libby at 636-225-3977 for ride times.
14. Dogs must be kept on a short leash.
15. No concessions on show grounds; easy access to restaurants in the area
16. **No entries accepted after closing date without permission of secretary.**
17. **NOTE REFUND POLICY: Entries may be cancelled for any reason prior to midnight on the closing date only in writing. AFTER MIDNIGHT ON CLOSING DATE NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON!!!**
18. If you choose to school the cross country course, you will need to sign the schooling form in addition to the dressage shows entry form.
19. A \$25.00 charge for a bounced check.

**STABLING** is not available.

**ARENA:** The ring will be set on grass. Small arena (20m x 40m) for classes 1-8 and 17-19, standard (20m x 60m) arena for classes 9-16. Schooling will not be allowed in the competition arena prior to the beginning of the show.
