Fun Show Rules 2013



- 1. Be respectful to others at all times; no name calling, no bad language, and no unsportsmanlike conduct!
- 2. No reckless riding. Please show good horsemanship.
- 3. Negative Coggins required.
- **4.** Stock horses may only show in stock classes. Gaited horses may only show in gaited classes. Open classes are open to both.
- 5. No youth under the age of 18 years old is allowed to show a stallion.
- 6. During speed events, the arena gate *must* be closed before you start your run. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- 7. Sign-up for classes will begin one hour prior to the start of the show. Please sign up early. The show will start on time!
- 8. If you are competing for year-end awards, you must work 2 shows, or attend one workday and work one show. (Ages 13 and up) Those under the age of 12 may have a parent fulfill this requirement. Our shows are run by volunteers and this will allow everyone to have a chance to compete.
- 9. There will be a 3 minute time limit between classes. When your name is called for speed, you will have 1 minute to be at the gate. *PLEASE BE READY!!!* *Exceptions for tack changes.
- 10. Jackpot classes are open to anyone. Payback is 50%, with the other 50% set aside to help purchase arena dirt.
- 11. Leadline speed classes do not have an age limit. (Within reason) However, if a rider is entered in leadline speed classes, they may not enter any other speed classes. However, they may ride in the judged classes.
- 12. Gaited classes are open to any gaited breed, any age exhibitor. If there are enough entries during the show season, points will be split for year-end awards. The splits will be: 15 & under and 16 & up.
- 13. Year-end points will be given through September, with the October show being used as a tiebreaker if needed.
