<u>RULES AND REGULATIONS</u> ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY ALL FEES AND UNLESS PROPERLY AND COMPLETELY FILLED OUT. STALL REQUESTS WILL NOT BE HELD WITHOUT MONEY.

The following paperwork must be submitted with entries: registration papers, measurement cards, USEF and ASHA membership cards and Coggins papers. All horses must have a horse ID number issued from USEF if not a registered breed. Owners and trainers at USEF recognized competitions rated "N" in all Saddlebred sections must be current members in good standing with the American Saddlebred Horse Association (ASHA). The original membership card or a copy must be presented. Membership forms are available in the Horse Show office. All Youth Medallion trainers, owners and competitors must be members of the American Hackney Horse Society (AHHS) in order to compete in their respective classes. All Hackney roadster ponies must be remeasured and issued new measurement cards prior to competing in recognized competitions for the year 2004 and beyond. In order to compete, all road horses must be Standardbreds registered with the United States Trotting Horse Association or the Canadian Trotting Horse Association, except for horses that have competed in any Roadster Division class at a USEF recognized event prior to December 1, 2003.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN, WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

The St. Louis National Charity Horse Show Committee reserves the right to itself of declining to receive any Exhibitor and/or horse to show and the right to order from the grounds any Exhibitor, horse or groom, without penalty of compensation.

ENTRIES must be postmarked by September 8, 2017, to avoid a late penalty. Entries will not be accepted over the telephone. Proper horse identity should be specified on the entry form and not general words such as "Entry". All entry blanks must be properly signed by an adult. All horses will be charged a non-refundable office fee of \$35 per horse. All horses or ponies must have either a horse ID number issued from USEF or a breed registration number in order to show. This number must be listed on the entry blank. Entries will only be accepted on the official St. Louis National Charity Horse Show entry blank, which is enclosed in the prize list or available on line. You may make additional copies if needed. Entries made on any other entry blank will be returned.

POST ENTRIES - Entries postmarked after September 8, 2017, will be charged a post entry fee of \$25 per horse. This will be in addition to all other normal fees. Entries will be accepted up to one hour before the scheduled start of each session. An unsigned open check mailed with the entries will be considered as a post entry. Entries without payment will also be considered as a post entry and fees will apply.

PAYMENTS - Checks &/or Visa/MasterCard are acceptable payments for your entries. If you choose to use a Visa/MasterCard a 4% processing fee will be added to the total.

STALL FEES are \$135 per stall. Stalls are permanent (10 X 10) with full doors. Temporary stalls may be used if entries require. Horses arriving prior to noon on Monday September 25, 2017 will be charged an early arrival fee of \$30 per day per stall. Stall fees must accompany entry form. EXTRA CHARGES FOR REMOVAL OR ALTERING DOORS. All horses must have a stall.

ELECTRICAL – All extension cords must be Underwriters Laboratory approved for outdoor use. Show management will inspect use of electrical appliances and extension cords. THESE RULES ARE FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE EXHIBITOR, HIS LIVESTOCK, FELLOW EXHIBITORS AND THE PUBLIC.

INITIAL BEDDING will NOT be provided. Only bag shavings will be available for purchase from the show through the horse show office. Bedding can be ordered by filling out the space provided on the entry blank and your bedding will be at your stalls when you arrive. You can call (502) 314-7960 prior to the week of the show. During the show, order forms will be available in the show office. Feed and hay can be purchased through Straatmann's Feed Store by calling (636) 828-5314. Please note on entry blank your arrival date and time. NO BEDDING WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE BROUGHT IN BY AN OUTSIDE VENDOR. NEITHER BARK NOR SAWDUST WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE HAULED IN FROM THE OUTSIDE.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE – Scratches made within 1 hour of the start of each session will be accepted but the entry fees will be retained.

REFUNDS of Entry Fees will only be made upon presentation of a certificate of illness issued by a veterinarian on an official letterhead stating illness or lameness. Fees will be refunded minus a \$15 scratch horse fee and the non-refundable office fee per horse. Requests for stall refunds after September 8, 2017, will not be honored. No refunds due to act of God or other emergencies.

RESPONSIBILITY - Neither the St. Louis National Charity Horse Show nor the National Equestrian Center at Lake Saint Louis will be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, stolen or destroyed, nor liable for any accident, loss, damage or injury that may occur to any Exhibitor, Owner, Trainer, Agent, Groom, Individual or Spectator sustained while at the St. Louis National Charity Horse Show. This shall be incorporated as a condition of entry or admittance to the Show.

CURRENT RULES of the USEF relating to Drugs and Medications will be enforced. A \$16 USEF fee per horse (D&M \$8, USEF fee \$8) must accompany entry form.

AMATEUR EXHIBITORS - Every person who has reached his or her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under USEF rules must possess an Amateur Card issued by the Association. An amateur card may be applied for at the show office prior to the competition.

ALL PONIES must present a valid or permanent measurement card issued by the USEF or CEF or be measured prior to numbers being issued where applicable. Photocopies are acceptable. MEASUREMENT ON WEDNESDAY 9:00 AM, SEPTEMBER 27, 2017.

THREE ENTRIES are required to fill a class. Fewer than three may be cause for cancellation or combining the class, at the option of the management.

HEALTH REGULATIONS – IMPORTANT

The St. Louis National Charity Horse Show follows the guidelines of the State of MO and the United States Equestrian Federation to protect the health and safety of all the horses at the show. At the printing of the prize list, the following are the requirements for all horses entering the property.

- 1. All horses must have proof of negative coggins test performed within 12 months of the show.
- 2. All out of state horses must have a Health Certificate within 12 months of the show.
- 3. VEE vaccination within 14 days f entry on horses originating from states in which VEE has been diagnosed within the preceding 12 months. An entry permit is also required on horses from such states.
- 4. USEF GR 845
 - 1. All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months prior to entering the property. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consists of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of the vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
 - 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations, name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
 - 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
 - 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon requests by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

Copies of all necessary health papers can be mailed with entries or copies will be requested at the horse show office at check in.

NAMES of Horses must be on the Entry Form. The word "Entry" may not be used. All horses must be entered in their full registered name and number and in the owner of record.

REGISTRATION PAPERS: A photocopy of Registration Papers showing current ownership must accompany each horse entered in the American Saddlebred division, each Pony entered in the Hackney and Hackney Harness Pony division and Road Horses. Numbers will not be issued for an entry in this division without proper proof of registration.

Fees: Payment of all fees must be made in US Funds. A penalty of \$50.00 will be charged for all non - negotiable funds. Management reserves the right to prohibit from competition and return the entry of any owner, rider, driver or trainer whose processing or entry fee payment has been returned as non - negotiable on one or more occasions. The horse show reserves the right to require guaranteed funds from exhibitors. When you provide a check or credit card as payment, you authorize us either to use information from your check to make a one - time electronic funds transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check transaction.

Please Note: Failure to promptly clear any outstanding debt with the Saint Louis National Charity Horse Show will result in a complaint filed with USEF.

PRIZE MONEY will be paid to the payee information provided on the entry blank. A Social Security Number or Federal Id number MUST be provided. Premiums will not be applied to show fees and will be mailed within 30 days following the show.

LINING-UP – When the line-up is called for, exhibitors are required by the rules to continue in a clockwise direction to bring their entries to the line. Judges are required to penalize entries that do not comply. (SB107.1)

JUDGING SYSTEM - Three judge majority opinion system will be used in all Saddlebred, Roadster Horse, Pony and Equitation classes, Adult and Junior Shatner Finals and Saddlebred Hunter Finals. Academy classes will be judged by a single judge. The Medallion Finals, Working Western Pleasure & The Saddle & Bridle Hunter Over Fences will have its own scoring system. Should unforeseen circumstances arise, the show management reserves the right to add or substitute judges if necessary.

WE LOVE DOGS, BUT – Dogs are permitted at the show ONLY IF THEY ARE CONFINED TO STABLE AND TACK ROOM AREA and they must be kept tied or on a leash. NO DOGS ALLOWED IN COLISEUM OR HORSE SHOW OFFICE.

FOOTING - Rings and warm-up areas are a combination of sand, dirt and clay. The size of the arena is 120' X 240'.

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS – Use of any explosives, including firecrackers, and fire extinguishers is prohibited anywhere on the show grounds except in case of fire. Any such devices found will be confiscated. ATTENDANTS, GROOMS OR TRAINERS MAY NOT USE ATTENTION GETTING DEVICES OF ANY KIND IN OR AROUND THE SHOW ARENA DURING SHOW PERFORMANCES. THE STEWARD WILL BE INSTRUCTED TO ENFORCE THIS RULE. LASH WHIPS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON VICTORY PASS OR IN WARM UP ARENA DURING PERFORMANCES.

EXHIBITORS AND ATTENDANTS: DUTIES AND APPEARANCE – All attendants in charge of horses or assisting with the preparation and showing of the horses will be subject to the orders of the Horse Show Manager. As the show expects to receive substantial amounts of video coverage, the management requests that all exhibitors present themselves and their attendants in appropriate attire at all times in or around the ring. Exhibitors are also cautioned as to their conduct in the ring and the schooling areas, especially with respect to training and schooling of horses.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT – Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the

following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE – Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. (If your competition bans motorized vehicles, please contact our office for further instruction.)

Number, UPHA Membership No, etc.) Make checks payable to St. Louis National Charity Horse Show and **not** UPHA. **Owners and Trainers must be current members of the UPHA**.

2. This Championship Class will include rail work and a posted individual workout. The rail work consists of the walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. The workout will be created from tests 1 - 16. Class will be judged based on 50% rail work and 50% workout using the SEN system. All riders will execute the workout.

3. Horses cross entered in the Country Pleasure division at the same competition may not wear tail sets or bustles while on the grounds. Riders competing in these classes cannot compete in any other Saddle Seat Equitation classes at the same competition except USEF Saddle Seat Medal, UPHA, NHS and American Saddlebred Pleasure Classes.

4. Eligibility is limited to riders showing registered American Saddlebreds or registered Half American Saddlebreds, but does not exclude Saddle Seat Equitation riders competing in other competitions on other breeds. 5. To be eligible, the riders must have shown in **at least three shows** and all Pleasure Equitation Classes can be counted toward qualification as long as a pleasure Saddlebred or Half American Saddlebred is ridden.

6. The qualification season begins after the final is held. Following the Championship class, the horse can be exhibited with a brace until December 1st without jeopardizing their eligibility for the following year's qualification although during this time none of the classes will count toward qualification. The winner will get a \$1,000 scholarship donated by Knollwood Knockouts.

ACADEMY DIVISION

This division is created for students in riding lesson programs participating only on horses used regularly for lessons for more than one rider.

1. Riders to wear jodhpurs, jod boots, and shirt with tie. Gloves, sweaters or vests are optional.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR IS MANDATORY.

2. Riders are not allowed to participate in any other equitation classes.

3. Lesson horses are only those horses owned or leased by the riding academy. A copy of the lease agreement or the bill of sale must be filed with the

Saddlebred/Other Points Secretary for its points to count for Academy Pleasure. Lesson horses are those used in the riding program for more than one rider. Horses may cross enter into other divisions. Flat saddles are to be used with any type bridles.

4. Academy classes must be split if six or more entries are in a class.

5. Becker Brothers WTC Challenge is a clinic-style class; the judge provides live commentary as the riders do their rail work and execute an advanced-level pattern. This class is for 'graduating' academy riders. If a rider wins the class, they may not enter again. By special permission from the MHSA, this class is open to 10 riders on a first come, first serve basis. There will be no splits. Only one rider will be recognized as the champion; all riders will receive a participation ribbon. The champion will receive a \$500 gift certificate, generously donated by Becker Brothers.


